## 2. Terms

Both parties agree to the following terms:

- a. "Confidential Information" is any and all data, ideas, or information related to the business relationship including:
  - i. Intellectual Property
  - ii. Industry "Secrets"
  - iii. Product and Service Information
  - iv. Customer or Client Information
  - v. Vendor Information
  - vi. Technology and Processes
  - vii. Marketing and Communications Materials
  - viii. Business or Product Development Information
- b. What is <u>not</u> considered "Confidential Information":
  - i. Common industry knowledge that would be known outside of the organization.
  - ii. General information that is made available to the public.
  - iii. Information known or in possession by the "Recipient" prior to the Confidentiality Agreement.
  - iv. Information obtained by the "Recipient" from a third party who has the right to disclose it.
  - v. Information created or developed by the "Recipient" without the use of "Confidential Information" provided by the "Creator".

## c. Obligations:

i. The "Recipient" must keep all "Confidential Information" outlined in this agreement confidential.



- ii. The "Recipient" will not use any "Confidential Information" received or developed on behalf of the "Creator" in a way that may cause harm or be detrimental to the "Creator".
- iii. The "Recipient" may disclose "Confidential Information" to any internal representatives, agents, employees, or others that have a reasonable need to know the information.
- iv. The "Recipient" may also disclose "Confidential Information" to any third parties with written consent from the "Creator".
- v. The obligations of this agreement go into effect on the effective date and will remain in effect until termination of this agreement.
